WELCOME FROM HOLY CROSS & ST MARY'S CHURCH



Dear friends,

It was 1966 (ouch!), and with a low-slung Broadway solid electric guitar, which cost around £7.14s.6d. (secondhand), and my supercool sixties image, complete with adequate haircut and sideburns, I hit the headlines in the Sheerness Times Guardian! It took me completely by surprise! I never thought I'd be shot at verbally by someone I was supposedly representing! Here was a clergyman going public on the evils of 'beat music' and the audacity of young whipper snappers claiming to be communicators of spiritual truth. I'm several decades older now, but I think I still worry some people when I get my guitar out in church!

Back in '66 the headline in the paper went like this: 'BEAT GROUP BID TO SAVE CHURCH' – 'The Victory Side'—the Island's own Gospel Beat Group—has been called in to save Queenborough's ancient Congregational church. Dwindling congregations in the past years have necessitated this move by organist Mr Harry Poppleton and lay preacher Mr Colin Steele." This sparked a series of letters to the newspaper with the correspondence coming to a conclusion with yet another headline in the newspaper! 'VICTORY FOR BEAT GROUP' I never intended to cause offence and was shocked that bringing contemporary music into the church would cause such a stir!

"News of the services conducted by the Island's Gospel Beat Group, 'The Victory Side' at Queenborough Congregational Church on Sunday, was flashed across Britain over the BBC Home Service on Monday." But on the "letters" page of the newspaper, the battle raged on!

"Sir, it is possible that your news item, 'Beat Group Bid to Save Church' could be misconstrued by a casual reader... I would like to point out that a policy of directing one's efforts to one small section of the community to whom too much attention is already paid—the teenage community—could well drive away members of long standing who have supported the church loyally." (Rev P. E. Gee)

Following a number of responses, the Reverend wrote again... "Sir, my efforts to set the record right as far as my own church is concerned, regarding the place of 'beat' services in our area, seems in danger of becoming a first-class argument. The teenage element must be prepared to forget the dominance which it has in the world outside by virtue of its high purchasing power, bizarre costume and uncouth appearance." (Rev P. E. Gee) Letters like these appeared in the paper for several weeks, some supporting the way we were trying to reach the kids on the street with the good news about Jesus, and others supporting the more traditional view of the clergyman.

I've come to the conclusion over the years, that to have integrity as a vicar, I can only be myself!







'Prospect House' 31 The Green

Some of you may have noticed that 31 The Green has a 'new' house name? Ever since we moved here in 1970, with our four young teenage children, I had on my "to do list" that my wish was to have the name put up over the front door. 53 years later, I have achieved it!

Being in a Conservation area of the village, I thought people would be interested to learn a little bit of history about the name of 'Prospect' and where it fits into the story of The Green. The driveway at the side of my house goes down to our garages but in Victorian or earlier times, this driveway was called 'Prospect Alley' which led down to a cluster of 4 or 5 cottages. These were demolished, I am guessing, around the beginning of the 20th Century and our garages were built from the reclaimed tiles and bricks of those cottages. I have always felt I wished to resurrect the old historic name, so one of my sons sourced the beautiful old piece of walnut and



prepared it, so that my eldest son, was then able to carve out the name 'Prospect House'.



July 2023 Edition - HS2 in Quainton

At HS2 and EKFB, we strive to find new ways to accommodate community requests along the line of route. In May, we were approached to help facilitate a key event for residents around the Waddesdon area.

Every 7 years, communities in Buckinghamshire parishes take part in the years old tradition of 'Beating the Bounds'. However, this year the Grendon Underwood and Waddesdon parish routes had been divided by the HS2 works.



Our representatives helped organise safe crossings for the 'bounders' to continue their walk across small sections of our site. We are proud that we were able to show our support for this long-standing community tradition.

Moving into our construction update, from June 2023 we will be continuing preparations for the Station Road realignment.

- From 10 23 July, Station Road at the junction with Quainton Road and Fiddlers Field/ Snakes Lane will be under 3 way temporary traffic lights. We will be undertaking works to connect a water main along the southern section of Station Road at the junction with Quainton Road and Fiddlers Field/Snakes Lane.
- On Station Road, the current closure of the northern section will remain in place until November 2023 with signed diversions. This is so Network Rail can complete necessary changes to make the Station Road Bridge safe for continued use and to support movement of material from the Quainton Railhead.
- On Blackgrove Road, our temporary 2-way traffic lights will remain in place at the plant crossing point.
- On the A41 temporary roundabout outside the EFKB A41 Compound, our temporary 2-way traffic lights will remain in place to allow plant to cross the roundabout when necessary.

Please note: these dates may change due to conditions outside of our control. Please refer to the HS2 website regularly to check for any changes and updates or to view the detailed Advanced Works Notification.





RAMBLINGS FROM FINEMERE WOOD: Charlotte Karmali, Volunteer Warden

Summer has arrived, and with it comes the blossoming of flowers and the flight of butterflies. Each visit to Finemere stuns us with the emergence of another species. Senses are overloaded with the wonder of bird song, the vibrancy of flora and the buzzing of invertebrates. The grassy rides are awash with Common spotted orchids. Each year numbers increase, as they become more widespread. Pyramidal orchids have also been spotted on the site: they dazzle with their exquisite, vibrant-pink flower spikes.

But the volunteers must be set to work amidst this overwhelming beauty. For without their labours to maintain the variety of habitats, Finemere Wood would not be the diverse and glorious refuge that it is today.

Nature is left to flourish as the volunteers turn their attention to the infrastructure of the reserve. The adjoining meadows are where the work is to be found this month. Management of this grassland involves grazing by livestock. This greatly reduces the competition from dominant plants such as thistles, nettles and ragwort, thus more delicate grasses and wildflowers are able to thrive. A demolition gang are directed to dilapidated fences. With hammers, wire cutters and muscle power the dismantling of wood and wire is skilfully tackled, making way for new, stock-proof fences to be raised.



Grass vetchling (Lathyrus nissolia) is a stunning and inconspicuous plant of the Pea family. Found in open, dry and grassy places, its flowers appear to float amongst the vegetation. With grass-like leaves, it is not immediately distinguishable from the surrounding pasture. Growing up to 60cm, either one or two small and delicate bright-pink flowers dangle from the syelte stalk. Mainly found in the South and South East of England, Lathyrus nissolia is

considered to be scarce, it is, however, on the increase. Never has there been so much Grass vetchling in the

Finemere meadows. It is rewarding to see how far and wide it has spread.







The fences are down in the blink of an eye and the volunteers muster for a slice of lemon drizzle cake. Minds must now be turned to the conundrum of fixing sections of existing fence....perhaps another slice of cake would help.


