#### Timely Debut Novel from Quainton Resident

Chris Hammonds has written dozens of short stories, but 'Dodgson's Dodo' is his first published novel, and if you are someone who cares about our planet and its future this is a book to give you food for thought. But if that sounds very serious, this is fiction and there's plenty of adventure and fun to keep you entertained.

It's the story of six characters, all birds, but this is not a children's story. It's definitely for grown-ups! What begins as a quirky woodland tale evolves into a challenge to the mismanagement of the environment by humans, and their abuse of power over all other species. There's banter between the birds, information about the natural world; there's serious debate and there's satire. It's a story that takes the birds on an unlikely but intriguing journey from woodland to Westminster.

The title refers to the fact that Charles Dodgson (Lewis Carroll) immortalised the otherwise extinct dodo in 'Alice's Adventures in Wonderland'. The dodo was yesterday's bird, but what will be the fate of tomorrow's birds, of tomorrow's humans and of our fragile, suffering planet?

The hero of 'Dodgson's Dodo' is a feisty rook, Rachel, who plays a smart role in this fascinating and imaginative story. All the birds are real characters, and everyone reading it will be both entertained and better informed. It's witty and memorable, but above all it's topical and relevant. Its message is urgent.

Chris has lived and worked in several different countries, but has been a Quainton resident for a number of years. He has three children

and eight grandchildren, and 'Dodgson's Dodo' is dedicated to his grandchildren and to all the other grandchildren of the world. After all, the planet we inhabit will belong to them, and it's our responsibility as adults to change the way we operate if the planet they inherit is to be the worthy and beautiful place it should be.

For anyone with an interest in nature, environmental issues, society, language, the big wide world – this could be your way into several hours of pleasurable and worthwhile reading. 'Dodgson's Dodo' is available from Amazon in hardback, paperback and for Kindle.

**Bus Service / Station Road Bridge / HS2:** This is now under the newly formed Quainton HS2 Forum with our Ward Councillors Iain Macpherson and Phil Gomm.

Network Rail are now expecting to take down the old bridge in September 2023 and then build the new bridge. We are still assuming that works will be carried out and finished by November 2023.

**ROADS:** The Willows (Quainton to Blackgrove Road) and The Strand are on the list for a plane & patch treatment next year! The roads have been 'Velocity patched' in the summer which has improved conditions slightly and will hopefully hold up over the winter months.

**Snake Lane / Fidlers Field:** we are waiting to see if HS2 can release more funds for consequential damage repairs, the Local Area Technician has reported that the road is subject to a more routine, once a month inspection regime, instead of an annual routine inspection. So over the coming months we will be able to keep on top of the situation and keep the road safe at least.





#### A Greenway Forward

Currently, residents in the Claydons can find it daunting to cycle between local villages or to Buckingham and Winslow due to fast moving traffic on our winding country roads. With the current high prices for petrol and diesel, and expected rises in the future, we are being encouraged to find greener ways to travel for journeys with a distance of 6 miles or less.

Claydon Cycling Club are excited to announce we are working with Greenway and Cycleroutes Limited, a charity set up to help local communities develop walking and cycling routes.

We have been invited to collaborate on the Buckinghamshire Greenway Project, an accessible, high-quality active travel route, connecting people and communities running the full length of the county.

The project already has a fully operating route between Wendover and Waddesdon, with the additional cycleway being added to join Colne Valley Park in the South, to Brackley in the North of the county.

Club members have been out in the fields looking at the planned route, spanning from Greatmoor to Buckingham, which will run through Steeple Claydon and some other local villages.

The 3 metre wide asphalt cycleway will be a great addition to the area and will hopefully encourage many more local people to skate, scoot or cycle to Buckingham, Aylesbury and beyond for work, education or social activities. The Greenway is also planned to link up with rail and bus services, helping with a safe alternative to local car journeys.

This is part of a vision for a North-South National Cycleway connecting London and the West Midlands, and communities in between.

Alongside local community based groups, like Claydon Cycling Club, Buckinghamshire Council, Sustrans and the Department for Transport are all involved to bring the Buckinghamshire Greenway vision to life.

#### **HS2** in Quainton

In the coming months, we will be progressing with the re-alignment of the A41. The works will be split up into two phases. The first phase of the works will be completed in the Winter of 2022; the second phase will be completed by Summer 2023.



Most of the work will be completed offline to reduce the amount of disruption to local traffic. During this period the A41 road will be open as usual. However, during the first phase, there will be a week closure of Blackgrove Road in early November 2022 to a facilitate utility diversions and new road tie-in.

Prior to this work we will be conducting trial holes which will allow us to inspect the utilities underground ahead of the utility diversion works Winter 2022.

In September, we organised a volunteer day at Quainton Primary School. The team from EKFB and HS2 spent two days revitalising Quainton Primary School by painting seven classrooms, covering close to 300 square metres. This volunteering event is the latest in our ongoing commitment to Quainton Primary School. Last month, members of the team visited the school to transform their outdoor area into a haven for wildlife and a great space for outdoor learning for students to enjoy for years to come.



#### RAMBLINGS FROM FINEMERE WOOD: Charlotte Karmali, Volunteer Warden

The long hot Summer sun has been replaced by the golden rays of autumnal sunshine. The leaves are turning: warm shades of red, yellow and brown adorn Finemere Wood.

And yet the Summer work is not yet complete. With tractor operators out of action, the woodland workers have had to cut many of the grassy rides manually.

Luck would have it, that amongst us is David Richardson. A master of the scythe, David has, this year, taught many Finemere volunteers how to scythe safely and competently. He is clear in his instruction, patient with his learners, and always on hand for those needing a refresher. This October he received a Volunteer Award for his outstanding contribution to BBOWT, and to Finemere Wood in particular. A committed and invaluable member since 2016, he has barely missed a gathering, come rain or shine. This award is well deserved.

David is a skilled woodturner, wood carver, and all-round talented craftsman. Keen to make use of the trees that are cut down, he creates beautiful things from Finemere oak, such as bowls and chopping boards. Donations are made by members of the team, in return for possession of one of these greatly desirable works of art. The money raised is used to buy more scythes.

More scythes and more scythers mean that the cutting of grassy habitats, essential in enabling wildflowers and invertebrates to flourish, can be done quickly, efficiently, and in a sustainable manner. This new skill is empowering for the Finemere Wood volunteers, giving greater independence and flexibility to nurture this haven for wildlife.



I left the army of scythers to their work for a wander around the wood and inadvertently disturbed a tawny owl from its roosting site. It perched on a branch just metres away before flying off.





The tawny owl (*Strix aluco*), is a finely-tuned woodland hunter. With its highly sensitive sight and hearing, and its short wings, it can weave in and out of the trees soundlessly, catching its prey unaware. Mating for life, tawny owls will defend their territory throughout the year. Eggs are often laid in the cavities of old trees.

Since the 1970s, the population of these beautiful creatures has declined by a third. The loss of broadleaved woodland is likely to be a contributing factor. Having heard the owls calling in the wood, to see one was a real gift. Finemere is an absolute gem, and it must be preserved for the survival of all creatures great and small.
